



San Joaquin 99s Nancy Fouquet Memorial Scholarship

Purpose

The San Joaquin Chapter of the Ninety-Nines International Organization of Women Pilots, Inc., is offering one - \$500 scholarship to local women. The scholarship can be used by the recipient to obtain a Private Pilot License or toward an advanced rating.

Eligibility

The applicant must be a resident of California.

The applicant must have passed the written exam, soloed and have a current medical before money is awarded, but not necessarily before application. If an advanced rating is the goal the applicant must also have a current flight review and all prerequisite ratings for the rating she seeks before money will be awarded, but not necessarily before application.

- Must be a current 99's member prior to award
- If under the age of 18 years old, the applicant must have the consent of a parent or guardian
- The applicant must be proficient in English

Application Guidelines

The application must be completed in full using the attached form. Upon completion, *mail original and three copies to:*

The application will be judged on the applicant's:

- Activities in and commitment to aviation
- Ability to reach goals

- Financial need as shown in her budget as submitted
- Personal essay
- Letters of recommendation

Terms

If the recipient does not complete the rating appropriate to her award within one year of the award date, her status will be reviewed. Special circumstances will be considered. Copies of her logbook shall be provided quarterly along with a report by her instructor during this year. If her progress is not acceptable, all funds must be reimbursed to the San Joaquin Chapter of the Ninety-Nines within sixty days of that decision

The scholarship monies will be paid directly to the Flight School or independent flight instructor conducting the training. Receipts showing hours flown and signed by both student and flight instructor must be submitted before funds are awarded.

Award Limitations

Applicants are not eligible to win more than one scholarship per certificate or rating and no more than two scholarships from the San Joaquin Chapter. Scholarships are intended to help fund a certificate or rating and are to be applied to aircraft rental or flight instruction fees for the specific certificate or rating in this application. Awards may not be used to pay for flying club dues/membership, ground school fees, books or other pilot supplies.

Letters of Recommendation (up to three) from persons knowledgeable about your interest or accomplishments in aviation. Provide email and/or phone contact information for each person issuing a letter of recommendation.

If you are selected, to whom shall the award funds be paid? This must be the individual or organization providing your flight training.
